In order to assist in the construction of these MSU's the Cluster will facilitate a training section which will incorporate warehouse management and the practical exercise of MSU construction. The Cluster will do the following:

- Conduct one training session, in Bogale. And if it necessary, another in Labutta.
- The training will take three days, one day of training in:
 - warehouse management
 - base preparation and drainage.
 - MSU construction, care, and removal.

The second and third days will involve the complete installation of a single MSU.

- The logistics cluster will provide lunch for all three days, but accommodation will be the responsibility of the individual organizations.
- The training will be "hands on training", meaning all participants will be taking an active part in the physical installation.
- The training will be coordinated by Matthew Serventy – with training done by S. Htay Lwin, a WFP log very experienced in MSU's.
- The dates of the training will be 21-23 July. Giving time to deliver MSUs and to prepare a base before installation.
