Minutes

A. Background

The Indonesian Government's medium-term National Development Plan (RPJMN) 2015-2019 has disaster management as one of its main priorities. One element of this plan is the development of a network of regional disaster-response logistics hubs, to be developed by the National Disaster Management Authority (BNPB).

To date, six areas have been identified: North Sumatra, South Sulawesi, East Java, South Kalimantan, Ambon, and Papua. The network of six hubs, once operational, will be known as **Sislogpalnas-PB** – the National System for Logistics and Equipment for Disaster Management.

The workshop was conducted in relation with the proposed regional hub to be located in **Makassar, South Sulawesi**.

B. Objectives

The objectives of the workshop including:

- Introduction *Sislogpalnas PB* and its series of activities to the Provincial government of South Sulawesi and the relevant stakeholders.
- Initiate the Logistics Coordination Group (LCG) – *same as Provincial Logistics Cluster*
- Agree on the *Sislogpalnas PB's* Component 1 action plan.

Key areas of discussion include:

- The development of a network of regional disaster-response logistics hubs, namely *Sislogpalnas PB*, aimed at increasing the logistics and equipment capacity. BNPB as the leading agency in disaster management with its role in command, coordination and implementation is currently developing the plan to build six regional logistics hubs in six provinces, including in Makassar, South Sulawesi.
- Key challenges in disaster management logistics are: the existing logistics system is not well coordinated, integrated, synergised with the key relevant line/ministries, therefore, it affected the time consumed for distribution; partially relief items distribution by different key line/ministries.
- The concept of Logistics Coordination Group (LCG) was introduced to the relevant stakeholders. The LCG will function as a forum of a multi-sectors coordination, information management, logistics capacity and resources sharing, and knowledge sharing.
- Funding source of *Sislogpalnas PB* is from BNPB and WFP for Fiscal Year 2018, focusing on Component 1 – Strategic Logistics Planning. Activities in the next fiscal years are expected be bore by BNPB and BPBD’s state and local budget.
- Time frame for the implementation of *Sislogpalnas PB* in South Sulawesi province:

 - Introduction of Logistics Capacity Assessment (LCA) and gaps identification
