

## Pakistan IDP operation – Snapshot 03

### Logistics Hubs in Bat Khela/Malakand

#### Introduction

The response of the Logistics Cluster to the IDP Operation in Pakistan is articulated around 4 services offered to UN agencies, International organisations and NGOs:

1. Inter-agency logistics coordination;
2. **Provision of transit hubs and free storage** for cargo consolidation and preparation for onward transportation;
3. Logistics information management (e.g. reports, maps, website);
4. Collaboration with and capacity building within the National Disaster Management Agency (NDMA).

This snapshot refers to the **warehouse facilities** secured by the Logistics Cluster to **temporary store commodities for all agencies and organisations** providing humanitarian assistance during the IDP operation. This service, as well as loading of trucks for onward transportation, is free of charge for an initial period of three months.

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#### Bat Khela/Malakand

##### **Location:**

District Secretariat, near District Courts Bat Khela

##### **Capacity:**

- 3x 12x 5m (180m<sup>2</sup>) concrete buildings
- 2x 12x 6m (144m<sup>2</sup>) concrete buildings

- can hold about 500mt

##### **Access:**

- road access is good
- entry and exit area are good
- ample parking
- good turning area
