

**Logistics Cluster – Meeting Minutes**  
**Typhoons - Emergency Response**  
**WFP Office, Manila**  
**Date: 3 February, 10:00am**

**1. Introduction and Situation update by Logistics Cluster**

- WFP Logistics Operation (SO 200080) has been extended until 31 March 2010
- The Logistics Cluster has been working with DSWD to improve logistics capacity through the provision of boats and tool kits. The Logistics Cluster is also looking into the possibility of providing other non-food items to assist with emergency warehouse operations.
- The Logistics Cluster has finalised the installation of four 110 KVA generators to medical centres in affected areas. Two estimates have been received for the repair of a 450 KVA generator at Region 1 Medical Centre in Dagupan that was damaged. Due to the high-estimated cost of repair without an on-site inspection (when compared to the replacement cost), the decision was taken to go ahead with an inspection only at this point in order to receive an actual quote for the repair.
- An online survey will be distributed to assess participant's views of the Logistics Cluster and to identify possible improvements that could be made in the future.
- The Logistics Cluster is working on the inter-agency Logistics Capacity Assessment which will provide information of logistics infrastructure across the Philippines. **2. Update for Organizations**

**WHO** – Currently planning the opening of the Mindanao office by the end of February.

**OXFAM** – Anticipate the end of operations by the end of March. Based on needs assessments, OXFAM is targeting 18,500 families in Rizal and Laguna for the distribution of "home return" kits. Distribution of hygiene kits is now complete. OXFAM has also imported 500 household water filter kits and consumables for water test kits.

**WFP** – Has distributed approximately 18,500 mt of food to date since October and planning sessions are underway for the implementation of early recovery activities involving food for work.
