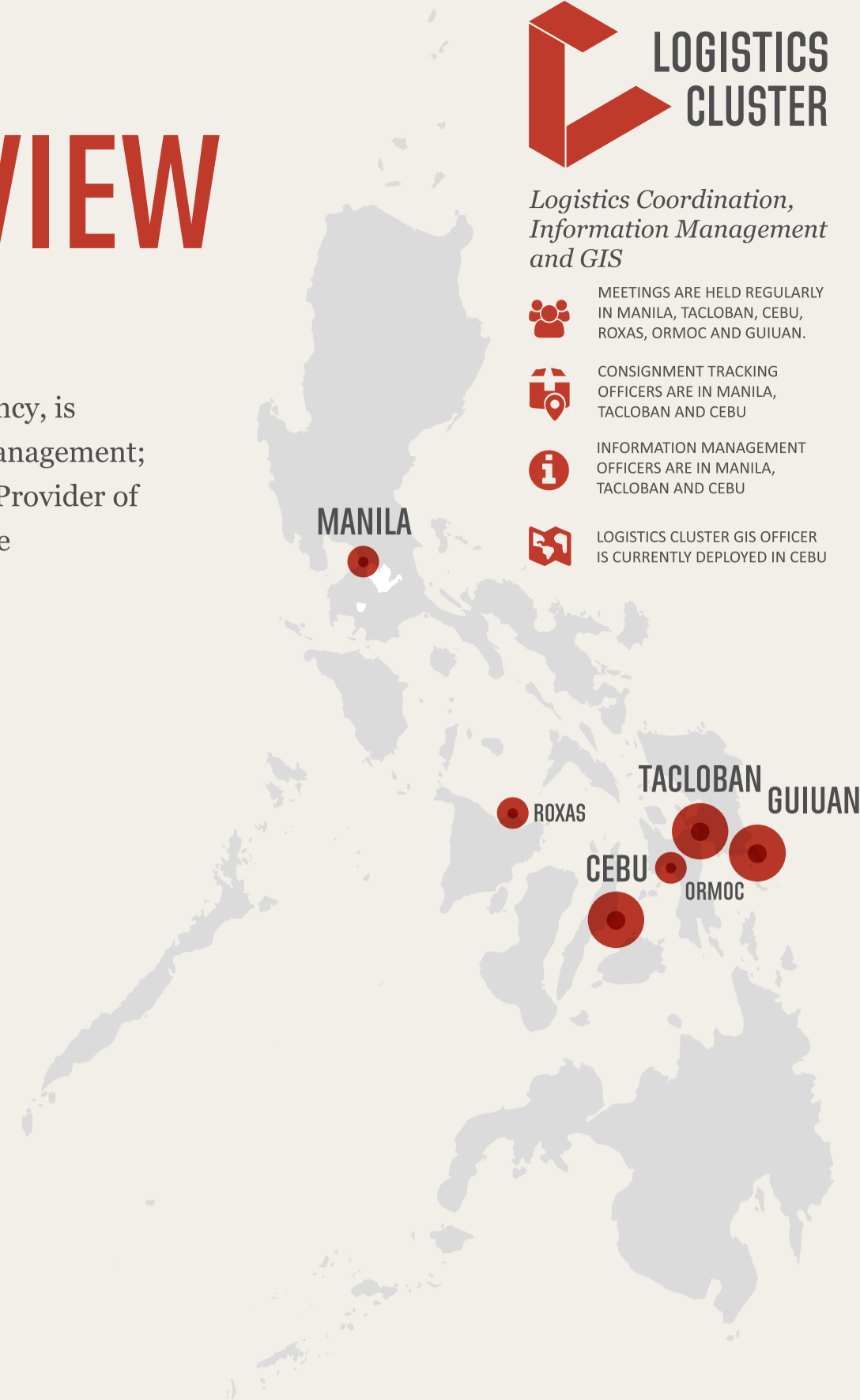

The Logistics Cluster, when activated in a sudden onset emergency, is responsible for providing logistics coordination, information management; and, where there is a gap in logistics infrastructure, it acts as a 'Provider of Last Resort' by offering common logistics services to support the humanitarian community in their response operations.



Governments (such as the Philippines, United States of America, Australia, the United Kingdom, New Zealand, Japan, Italy, the People's Republic of Korea, Canada, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore, and Sweden) provided essential operational support and assets, such as helicopters cargo planes and ships in the first weeks of the response, ensuring that life-saving assistance was dispatched as soon as possible.



The Logistics Cluster has facilitated cargo operations and provided logistics support and liaison through the deployment of Civ/Mil Coordinators in Manila, Cebu and Tacloban.
