HIGHLIGHTS

- UNHAS operations in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) ended on 28 February as agreed with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA).
- A total of 310 mt of food and non-food items (NFIs) were delivered by UNHAS in KPK since 21
 January for UNICEF, WFP, SUNGI Development Foundation, and Catholic Relief Services (CRS).
 These included 207 mt of NFIs and 103 mt of food. The locations served were Peach Bela,
 Karang, Shareed, and Dubair Mujh Ghali.

2 AIR OPERATIONS

- Overall, since air operations began on 5 August 2010, the Logistics Cluster has facilitated airlift of 12,267 mt (11,475 mt Food, 792 mt NFIs) of relief cargo for 15 organisations.
- The Logistics Cluster facilitated air operation in Pakistan is now completed.

3 COORDINATION

 As per the agreed exit strategy, the Logistics Cluster Coordination Cell in Peshawar closed down on 28 February. The only Logistics Cluster coordination cell now remaining in Pakistan is the national cell in Islamabad.

4 STORAGE

 In line with the agreed exit strategy, the Logistics Cluster has closed down temporary storage facilities in Pattan (KPK). These facilities were being utilized by SUNGI Development Foundation, Catholic Relief Services (CRS), WFP, and UNICEF for the storage of Non-Food Items (NFIs).
