1 HIGHLIGHTS

- The Logistics Cluster GIS Unit provided GPS training to humanitarian organisations in Peshawar. GPS trainings are planned for Sukkur, Islamabad and Multan over the coming weeks. Interested organisations should contact Anna.Schemper@wfp.org for further information.

2 AIR OPERATIONS

- Since air operations began on 5 August, the Logistics Cluster has coordinated airlifts of 10,856 mt of relief cargo for 13 organisations. From the total, 768 mt was delivered in the past week.
- Currently eight UNHAS helicopters are operating. They are based in Karachi and Sukkur.
- The Dadu area is the main focus of the operation in Sindh. Relief items continue to be airlifted in combined packages of food, shelter, WASH and nutrition items to facilitate joint distribution.
- In KPK, the Logistics Cluster facilitated air operation has now delivered 100 percent of the 1,200 mt of relief cargo requirements that were planned for the province in November. In addition, 295 mt of December requirements for KPK have been delivered to date.
- US military air operations in KPK are expected to cease on 30 November 2010.

3 ROAD UPDATES & MAPPING

- Currently the road to Kalam (KPK) can only be used by vehicles carrying loads of up to 1.5 mt.
- In Dadu (Sindh), roads in the Three Bunds area (FP Bund, Supprio Bund, and MNV Drain) are slowly opening up, but many areas can still only be accessed by air.
- The Logistics Cluster has produced updated road conditions maps of Sindh and northern Pakistan as well as a map of new delivery points in Dadu and Jamshoro (Sindh). The maps are available on the Logistics Cluster website at: <http://www.logcluster.org/ops/pak09a/maps>.
