

Overview:

The Limak Port facility is undergoing extensive construction to expand capacity, particularly related to handling containerised cargo.

Additional berths and equipment are expected to come online over the remainder of 2013:

- with a target capacity of 3 Million TEU/year within the next two years,
- 60 Ha of storage area,
- 2.550 mt of berthing,
- 500 mt turning basin.
