



In the past week, the number of ships discharging, at anchorage and expected to Hudaydah has steadily declined. As of 17 August, there are 6 vessels expected, however, this represents a decline from the previous four weeks.

Quick facts:

- WFP time chartered vessel VOS Apollo voyage 67 with passengers on board will sail from Djibouti to Aden on 20 August. The vessel with passengers on board will sail back from Aden onwards to Djibouti on 23 August.
- Dhow Al Zahra berthed in Djibouti and completed on 20 August loading medical supplies for WHO as part of the cholera response. The expected arrival date in Hudaydah is 22 August.
- MV Jumana is expected to berth soon in Berbera Port and will commence loading of 9,265 MT of bagged sugar and yellow split peas allocated for Aden and Hudaydah.
- MV E.R. BORDEAUX is expected to berth at US loading port by late August to load 46,000 MT of bulk wheat for Aden 16,000 MT and Hudaydah 30,000 MT. The estimated arrival time is 5 October 2017.
