The table below reflects updates received from other organisations and the private sector. As per the Logistics Cluster mandate, the information gathered focuses only on cargo transport, not passengers' restrictions. Also note that this list is not exhaustive and will be updated based on the information received on a day-to-day basis.

Panama	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	20 March	WFP
Peru	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Custom working on limited capacities.	24 March	Peruvian Ministry of Transport and Communications
Rwanda	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
South Africa	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Sudan	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Syria	Damascus, Aleppo and Qamishli airports are operating only for domestic cargo movements, no flights from outside the country. Lattakia and Tartous port are operating for cargo movements.	24 March	Logistics Cluster
