In an effort to have an overview of the impact of COVID-19 on Humanitarian Supply Chains in the world, the Logistics Cluster is compiling updates on entry point for cargo. The table below reflects updates received from other organisations and the private sector. As per the Logistics Cluster mandate, the information gathered focuses only on cargo transport, not passengers' restrictions. Also note that this list is not exhaustive and will be updated based on the information received on a day-to-day basis.

Afghanistan	Chaman border closed until 29 April. Borders with Russia and China are closed. The border with Iran has been re-opened.	26 March	WFP
Algeria	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Armenia	All borders closed with exceptions for goods coming through Iran and Georgia.	26 March	WFP
Belize	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Burkina Faso	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Cameroon	Land borders with Chad and Central African Republic remain open. Reported border closure with Gabon to be confirmed. 14 days of quarantine for ships entering Douala port .	23 March	Republic of Cameroon, WFP
Central African Republic	Commercial transport can cross the border from Cameroon.	25 March	WFP
Colombia	Border with Venezuela closed. Humanitarian cargo exceptions might be made through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Border to Ecuador remains open but transporter must be quarantined for 14 days upon return.	25 March	WFP
Republic of Congo	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP

Cote d'Ivoire	Cargo trucks allowed to pass land borders.	26 March	WFP
Cuba	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Chad	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Djibouti	Humanitarian and cargo flights are not interrupted. Ports are asking to submit documents on last 10 ports calls for all vessels 72 hours before arrival. Rail and truck cargo is uninterrupted.	23 March	WFP
Dominican Republic	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	25 March	WFP
Gabon	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Ghana	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Guinee-Bissau	Closure of all land, air and sea transport excluding medical and food imports of basic needs.	23 March	WFP
Haiti	Border with Dominican Republic remains open for cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Honduras	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Equipment for hospital use and/or medicines donations arriving at San Pedro Sula Airport must have an authorization from the National Risk Management System 24h before arrival.	25 March	WFP
Ecuador	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Egypt	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Increased checks and measures at entry points.	25 March	WFP
Eritrea	Cargo flights allowed. Land border with Ethiopia fully closed.	26 March	WFP
Ethiopia	Cargo flights allowed. Land border only allowed for essential goods. Road and river access to South Sudan is allowed.	26 March	WFP
India	Exports to Bangladesh, Nepal and Buthan are still possible. Certain cargo flights are grounded.	17 March	Agility WFP
Jordan	Jordanian trucks are not allowed to cross to Syria, Israel, and the West Bank.	26 March	Jordanian Ministry of Transport WFP

Paraguay	Only authorized cargo can cross border with Brazil.	26 March	WFP

Rwanda	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Senegal	Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew.	26 March	Gouvernement of Senegal
Somalia	<p>Sea transport to all key supply ports accessible.</p> <p>Air transport out of Nairobi to Somalia ONLY possible for WFP/UNHAS with special approvals.</p> <p>Internal air transport not restricted.</p>	26 March	WFP

Syria	Damascus, Aleppo and Qamishli airports are operating only for domestic cargo movements, no flights from outside the country. Lattakia and Tartous ports are operating for cargo movements. All working hours at points of entry have reduced.	26 March	Logistics Cluster
Tanzania	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Togo	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Stripping of containers at the port are suspended until further notice.	23 March	WFP
Venezuela	Cargo flights are allowed. Commercial trade continue with Brazil on land border. Seaports remain open.	25 March	Logistics Cluster
Yemen	Humanitarian cargo flights will be rescheduled but will continue to operate. Ports are open with quarantines for cargo and crew.	25 March	International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), WFP
