

Background

In an effort to have an overview of the impact of COVID-19 on Humanitarian Supply Chains in the world, the Logistics Cluster is compiling updates on entry point for cargo. The table below reflects updates received from other organisations and the private sector. As per the Logistics Cluster mandate, the information gathered focuses only on cargo transport, not passengers' restrictions. Also note that this list is not exhaustive and will be updated based on the information received on a day-to-day basis.

Afghanistan	Chaman border with Pakistan opened for food cargo. Border with China is closed. The border with Iran has been re-opened.	30 March	WFP Pakistani government
Algeria	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements, but operating at reduced capacity, delays to be expected. The port of Annaba will quarantine any ship that called Italian ports.	30 March	WFP Agility North P&I
Angola	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	27 March	WFP Agility North P&I
Armenia	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Trucks from Russia, Iran and Georgia must have 2 drivers.	30 March	WFP Armenian government

Colombia	<p>Border with Venezuela closed. Humanitarian cargo exceptions might be made through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Only food and essential items can cross road borders. Border to Ecuador remains open but transporter must be quarantined for 14 days upon return.</p> <p>Sea and air freight are allowed.</p>	27 March	WFP Agility

Gabon	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Ships must send list of called harbours and crew lists before berthing and may be subjected to quarantines.	30 March	WFP North P&I
Ghana	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Ships subjected to health checks and quarantines before berthing.	30 March	WFP
Guinea-Bissau	Closure of all land, air and sea transport excluding medical and food imports of basic needs.	23 March	WFP
Haiti	Border with Dominican Republic remains open for cargo movements with health screenings at the border. Ship cargo operations are being carried out normally.	30 March	WFP North P&I
Honduras	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Equipment for hospital use and/or medicines donations arriving at San Pedro Sula Airport must have an authorization from the National Risk Management System 24h before arrival.	25 March	WFP
India	Cargo flights , ships and trucks are constrained. Internal cargo movement is restricted to delivery of essential goods. Integrated checkpoints (ICPs) at all airports, seaports, land ports, rail ports, and river ports are closed. Exports to Bangladesh, Nepal and Bhutan are still possible.	27 March	WFP Agility DHL North P&I
Jordan	Air and sea cargo allowed. Cross-border road cargo restricted to essential items or food and facing serious delays. Jordanian trucks are not allowed to cross to Syria, Israel, and the West Bank.	26 March	Jordanian Ministry of Transport WFP Agility
Kenya	Cargo flight allowed but experiencing serious handling capacity reduction. Port operations are ongoing with restrictions for ships from China. Inland movements remain normal. Trucks with number plates from DRC and Rwanda are not allowed to enter. Trucks to South Sudan are allowed.	23 March	WFP Agility North P&I
Lebanon	Only cargo flights for relief cargo or essential items. Road and sea cargo operating at lower capacity. Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew.	30 March	Logistics Cluster Agility North P&I

Libya	Benghazi and Misrata airports remain open. Benghazi, Tripoli and Khom ports remain open. Land border with Egypt is closed. Border with Tunis remains open.	27 March	WFP
Madagascar	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Ports are asking to submit documents on last 10 ports calls and can be subject to quarantine.	23 March	Logistics Cluster Government of Madagascar
Malawi	Land border with Zimbabwe is closed.	27 March	Malawi government
Mexico	Border with the US remains open to road cargo movements. Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew, and operations are slower than usual.	30 March	DHL North P&I
Niger	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Nigeria	Air and road cargo only for humanitarian or essential items. Port operations are restricted. Internal cargo movement is restricted.	27 March	Agility
North Korea	Cargo entering from Dalian, China at Nampo port.	26 March	WFP
Oman	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	29 March	DHL
Palestine	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	25 March	WFP
Pakistan	All humanitarian and commercial cargo movements allowed but operating at lower efficiency. Cross border land cargo only for food and essential items. Customs operating at lower efficiency.	26 March	WFP Agility North P&I
Panama	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	20 March	WFP
Paraguay	Only authorized cargo can cross border with Brazil.	26 March	WFP
Peru	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements, but operating at reduced capacity, delays to be expected. Custom working on limited capacities. Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew. Internal cargo movement is restricted.	24 March	Peruvian Ministry of Transport and Communications Agility North P&I

Philippines	Davao airport only accepting humanitarian and essential good. Cebu Island and Cebu province remain open to all cargo movements.	27 March	Agility
Rwanda	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	23 March	WFP
Saudi Arabia	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	27 March	DHL
Serbia	Entry restrictions apply to truck drivers from Italy, Switzerland, Romania, Spain, France, Germany, Austria, Slovenia and Greece, which are required to quarantine upon arrival or may be rejected from entering altogether. For trucks transiting through the country drivers are obliged to leave the country within 12 hours.	27 March	DHL
Senegal	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew.	26 March	Senegalese Government WFP North
Somalia	Sea transport to all key supply ports accessible. Air transport out of Nairobi to Somalia ONLY possible for WFP/UNHAS with special approvals. Internal air transport not restricted.	26 March	WFP
South Africa	Cross-border land freight restricted to food and essential items, delays to be expected. Airports and ports open for cargo and operating at lower efficiency.	23 March	WFP Agility
South Sudan	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	25 March	Logistics Cluster
Sudan	Port Sudan remains open. Land transport to South Sudan is still possible.	23 March	WFP
Syria	Damascus, Aleppo and Qamishli airports are operating only for domestic cargo movements, no flights from outside the country. Lattakia and Tartous ports are operating for cargo movements.	26 March	Logistics Cluster
Tanzania	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements.	26 March	WFP
Togo	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Stripping of containers at the port are suspended until further notice. Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew.	30 March	WFP North P&I

Tunisia	All commercial borders are still open to cargo movements. Medicines donation and/or hospital equipment can be sent to Tunis-Carthage airport with an authorization from the government 72h prior to the flight.	29 March	WFP
Venezuela	Cargo flights are allowed. Commercial trade continues with Brazil on land border. Ports remain open with increased verification and restrictions for the crew.	25 March	Logistics Cluster North P&I
Yemen	Humanitarian cargo flights are allowed. Ports are open with quarantines for cargo and crew.	25 March	International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) WFP North P&I
