## 1. Access

---

- As road access is increasing, the use of air assets is focused on areas inaccessible by road as per priorities defined by OCHA.
- Partners are kindly asked to send their [SRFs](#) ahead of time to [Mozambique.clustercargo@wfp.org](mailto:Mozambique.clustercargo@wfp.org) in order to inform the Logistics Cluster about their cargo movements.
- The Logistics Cluster continues to support national authorities in terms of information sharing about road access and mapping.
- Available boat rental companies are liaising Beira port and south Buzi and contact details are the following:
  - Boat of 10 mt capacity: Ousmane +258 872852930
  - Boat of 8 mt capacity: Praia Nova +258 846692001 +258 840328415
- Organisations are encouraged to share updates with Atlas Logistique focal point ([pierretrouche@yahoo.fr](mailto:pierretrouche@yahoo.fr)) about road access and projects of rehabilitation. Four detailed road maps produced by Atlas Logistique are available [here](#) after roads assessments have been conducted last week in Chemba, Chinde, Savane and Muanza.
- Partners are encouraged to share access constraints information and other logistical information through the App 123Survey using this new [form](#) application to assess the impact of Cyclone Kenneth.

## 2. Air Operations and Storage

---

- Air assets
  - The use of the two Mi-8 WFP Aviation helicopters (3,5 mt capacity) will remain available until 7 May to ensure urgent cargo reaches areas that remain impossible to access by road. Any further extension beyond this date depends on the availability of funds.
  - Organisations wanting to request air transport are strongly encouraged to send their [Service Request Form](#) as soon as possible. To ensure the consistency of the information, dedicated guidelines to fill in the SRFs are available on the Logistics Cluster [website](#).
  - The Logistics Cluster is facilitating passenger requests on an ad hoc basis and based on the existing schedule of flights operated by the two Aviation helicopters. Organisations are encouraged to share their request with the Information Management Officer [Jeanne.decrepy@wfp.org](mailto:Jeanne.decrepy@wfp.org).
  - Mercy Air's assets remain available for the humanitarian community to reach areas inaccessible neither by overland transport nor by the two Mi8 aircrafts.
- Warehouse
  - The Logistics Cluster airport storage will no longer be used to store incoming cargo as of Friday 26 April. Partners who still have consignments at Beira airport should ensure all consignments are released by 26 April. The airport storage facility will be used as temporary capacity for cargo to be dispatched by air for the helicopters that will remain operational (Mi-8).
  - Storage facilities remain available in Beira, Chimoio, Buzi and Nhamatanda.
