1. Road Access and Constraints

- There is commercial road transport available in Beira. Partners are requested to advise the Logistics Cluster if they have any available space that could be utilised by another partner.
- There is a truck planned to depart for Pemba on Friday 10 May. Partners interested in sending cargo on the truck should submit an SRF to mozambique.clustercargo@wfp.org.
- Results of the road assessment conducted in Nhamatanda District by ANE and partners will be shared tomorrow, 9 May, at the next meeting on road access.
- The road from Tica to Buzi has a damaged culvert, with reports of cars becoming stuck yesterday. Trucks cannot pass, but cars can try although it is recommended to avoid this as there is a chance of collapse. There is currently no alternative route.
- Partners are encouraged to share road access information with the Logistics Cluster.

2. Common Services Updates

Air Operations

- There is one Mi8 helicopter available until mid-May. Any possible extension of this service will depend on the availability of funds and the demonstrated needs through partner requests.
- Partners are requested to submit their SRFs as soon as possible to assist in the planning of air operations during the WHO/MoH vaccination campaign which will be running on 9, 11 and 13 May.

Storage

- The Logistics Cluster common storage space at Beira Airport will be dismantled following the expected end of air operations in mid-May.
