1. Road Access and Constraints

- Partners informed the Logistics Cluster that there were no storage nor transport gap in Beira.
- As commercial road transport is available in Beira, as mentioned at the coordination meetings, the Logistics Cluster no longer receives any Service Request Forms ([SRF](#)) for road transport.
- Partners are encouraged to use the [Whatsapp group](#) as a collaboration tool to inform each other about their transport pipeline, in order to coordinate road transport.
- Partners are encouraged to share road access information with the Logistics Cluster.
- The ferry in Buzi is still not operational, and extra repairs are needed.
- Partners informed that at the port of Praia Nova, the shipper's association was able to provide contacts of boats owners for Buzi river. Here are two contacts for boat rental: Luis Alberto (+258840328415 /+25886171667) and Transporte Maritimo Sofia Lda (+258824535850 / +258843941550).

2. Common Services Updates

Storage

- The Logistics Cluster warehouse in Mafuia's rate of occupancy is 10%.
- The Logistics Cluster does not receive any [SRF](#) for storage and partners were encouraged to send their requests by the 14 June.
- Depending on needs and requests, the storage facility in Beira might be closing by the 30 June.
- The Logistics Cluster compiled a list of available storage facilities in Beira. This will be recirculated among partners via the mailing list.

Pemba

- There is one Mi8 helicopter available until the 14 June as road access is improving. The Logistics Cluster will no longer facilitate access to air transport from Pemba to other locations from this date. Consequently, no further Service Request Forms (SRFs) for air transport will be considered.

3. AOB

- WHO will organise a vaccination campaign from the 1 July and additional vehicles from partners will be needed.
