1. Road Access and Constraints

- The updated Access Constraints Map for central Mozambique can be found [here](#).

2. Common Services Updates

- Following extensive consultations in both Beira and Pemba, Logistics Cluster partners confirmed no existing logistics gaps, and that private sector is able to meet current storage and road transport needs.
- In light of this, common logistics services were discontinued in Beira on 30 June, and are foreseen to be discontinued in Cabo Delgado province by mid-July. Service requests will not be accepted from 1 July onward.
- In addition to service providers available on the local market, WFP is also offering Bilateral Logistics Service Provision in Mozambique for humanitarian organisations for port operations and cargo transport and storage. Conditions of services provided would be on full cost-recovery basis. WFP Head of Supply Chain may be contacted for more information. The Logistics Cluster can share the contact details to interested partners.

3. AOB

- Following a donation of two Mobile Storage Units (MSU) from MSF to WFP through the facilitation of the Logistics Cluster, and a request for two MSUs from the Mozambique Red Cross (CVM), it was agreed among WFP, MSF and Logistics Cluster partners that the two MSUs would be donated to CVM in Maputo.
- The Logistics Cluster shared the results of the users surveys for Idai and Kenneth responses. The surveys showed 92% of responders rated Logistics Cluster coordination as very good and good; 93% rated common logistics services as very good and good; 100% of responders graded IM services as very good and good; and, 84% noted that the Logistics Cluster contributed significant added value to their organisation's response.
- The Logistics Cluster is planning a training on the set up of MSUs before the end of the month.
- The Logistics Cluster agreed with partners that no further coordination meetings will be held in Beira.
