1. Road Access

- Accessibility to South Buzi is now improving with the road now accessible for trucks up to 10 mt.
- The Logistic Cluster continues to support organisations through the sharing of information about road access and mapping.
- Access is improving on primary roads, but some secondary and tertiary roads remain inaccessible. In Sofala province, several secondary roads are cut off in Nhamatanda, Buzi and Chibababva districts.
- Organisations are encouraged to share updates with the [Atlas Logistique focal point](#). Road assessments have been conducted in Chemba, Chinde, Savane and Muanza.
- The road from Chimoio to Dombe is accessible for 30 mt trucks.

2. Storage

- The Logistics Cluster currently has common storage space available in Chimoio, Beira and Pemba, however the Logistics Cluster warehouse in Chimoio will close by 31 May.
- Partners are requested to submit [Service Request Forms](#) as far in advance as possible to mozambique.clustercargo@wfp.org for common storage services at the Logistics Cluster warehouse, and inform the Logistics Cluster 24 hours before the arrival of cargo.
- Organisations were reminded to submit Release Order Forms to have their cargo released from the Logistics Cluster warehouse.

3. Partners Updates

- MSF is planning to remove all their Non-Food Items from the Logistics Cluster warehouse before 15 May.
- Swiss Humanitarian Aid removed all their items from the warehouse.
- UNICEF is looking for their own dedicated warehouse in the coming week in Chimoio and they will receive their new shipments directly into their own warehouse.
