1. Situation Update

- The Logistics Cluster centre of operations is based in Beira and staff member based in Maputo are being reallocated as needed. An IM Officer will remain in Maputo for an additional week and can be contacted at the following email address jeanne.decrepy@wfp.org if needed.
- The Logistics Cluster is scaling down air operations and partners are strongly encouraged to use overland and river transport. Information on transport and storage services provided by the Logistics Cluster are available on the Logistics Cluster dedicated [operation page](#) and detailed on the [Concept Of Operations](#).

2. Air Operations

- The airbridge (US Military) between Maputo and Beira will be deactivated the night of Wednesday 10 April. The Logistics Cluster team has been collecting Service Requests Forms (SRF)s for cargo ready to be loaded by Wednesday for these remaining flights. No more SRF can be accepted.
- The Logistics Cluster chartered fixed-wing (possible routes: Maputo - Beira and Maputo - Chimoio) will be deactivated the night of Friday 12 April. [SRFs](#) for cargo ready to be loaded by Friday must be received by COB Wednesday 10 April.

- Two Mi8 helicopters are based in Beira to access Chimoio and any other location around Beira upon request from partners.
 - A five-day training is ongoing at Beira airport for the Air Cargo Handling Equipment (ACHE) loaned by DFID.

3. Customs

- Organisations must obtain a [tax exemption letter](#) from the INGC to start the custom clearance procedures.
- Organisations are reminded to strictly comply with the [custom clearance requirements](#) before receiving cargo.
