1. Road Access and Constraints

- The Chai road is open linking northern provinces to Cabo Delgado.
- The road to Quissanga is still impassable.
- Metuge is currently inaccessible.
- Metuge bridge is currently only accessible for pedestrian traffic.
- Macomia bridge is operational.
- Meluco road is closed.
- The road to Beira is open but the journey takes longer than usual due to the poor condition of the road.
- The Logistics Cluster has requested a list of current and planned road works from the INGC.

2. Operations Update

- There is currently space available in the Logistics Cluster common storage space. Interested partners should submit a [service request form](#) (SRF) to mozambique.clustercargo@wfp.org.
- An update was provided on how to access Logistics Cluster common services and how to correctly complete SRFs. A guide to completing SRFs can be found [here](#).
- Certeza (chlorine) can be transported via Logistics Cluster helicopter without a dangerous goods form being completed.

3. Partner Updates

- CRS has identified a landing strip in Metuge previously landed on by INGC. They will share the coordinates.
- OIKOS advised that they have sent a boat to Ibo Island to transport fuel for the three boats already there.

- Welthungerhilfe will be operating in Nakuta locality.
- Samaritan's Purse and INGC are partnering with Iris Global for distribution of NFIs.
- INGC has requested that partners provide information regarding assessment criteria, what items have been and are being distributed, where they're being distributed, planned distributions and also length of response.
- INGC advised that they have a plan to target 250,000 people and have identified shelter and WASH as the main priorities.
