## 1. SITUATION UPDATE

### *Coordination/Information Management/GIS*

- Logistics Cluster continues to provide Logistics Coordination, Information management/GIS in Tacloban, Guiuan, Ormoc, Cebu, and Roxas.

### *Customs*

- One Stop Shop (OSS) is now completely operational in Manila and Cebu from 08:00 – 17:00. No organizations have reported any issues with the OSS.

### *Storage/Transport (Sea, Road)*

- Currently there has been no update on the resumption of operations at different sea ports after they were suspended due to a typhoon warning.
- The Logistics Cluster requested partners intending to use storage and transport (sea, road) services to continue submitting their requests so that the Cluster can plan capacities accordingly.
- The Logistics Cluster is currently planning the transition strategy and is scaling down its operations. It will continue to monitor commercial capacities, gaps and potential constraints.
- Following assessments and mapping of commercial storage and transportation capacities, substantial improvements have been witnessed. The partners are encouraged to start using the commercial capacities. Details can be found on the Logistics Cluster website: <http://www.logcluster.org/>
- The partners were asked if they were facing any gaps or constraints in Cebu for which they require the Logistics Cluster support. The participants confirmed that currently they are facing no gaps or constraints in Cebu.

### *UNHAS*

- UNHAS stated that they are encouraging partners to start using the commercial options as they are now available.
- The flights from Cebu to Tacloban have reduced from two to one daily from Monday to Saturday, operational until 31 January.
- From 1 February, UNHAS will only serve the locations not accessible by commercial flights including Roxas, Guiuan and Borongan on every Monday and Friday. On Wednesdays, UNHAS will only fly for MSF to most probably Guiuan.
- UNHAS is available seven days a week for emergencies including medevac and/or missions.

**Capacity Building**

- LET has trained 53 participants from the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and other organizations in Health and Safety measures in Warehousing Operations.
- A basic warehouse management training in handling NFIs is planned in Roxas. Organizations interested in participating can contact Rizwan Ali at [Rizwan.Ali@wfp.org](mailto:Rizwan.Ali@wfp.org).
- The Logistics Cluster is seeking interest of its partners to enhance local capacity through the design and implementation of practical /tailored training sessions. Partners are invited to propose topics of interests such as Basic warehouse management, Basic shipping operations, Mobile Storage Units (MSUs), basic data collection through GPS, maintenance of generators and etc.

**2. AOB**

- WHO is intending to transport some cold chain cargo from Cebu to Borongan and is looking for details of transporters dealing in cold chain transportation. Participants suggested contacting Zueltig Pharmaceuticals in Cebu who transports their own cold chain medicines, or Robinsons supermarket chain, and they might be able to support.
- WHO also inquired if anyone is aware of suppliers in Tacloban dealing in prefabricated offices and shelters. No one was aware of any supplier in Tacloban.
- IRD asked for list of transporters to transport back two excavators from Tacloban to Cebu. Samaritan stated that they can provide the details to IRD. The Logistics Cluster shared the list of transporters with participants and it is also available by contacting the Logistics Cluster.
- Partners agreed to hold the Logistics Cluster meeting in Cebu every two weeks from now on wards. The next Logistics Cluster coordination meeting will be held on **Monday, 03 February 2014 at 17:00**.

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
