## 1. Operational Updates

---

- The Logistics Cluster continues to facilitate cargo deliveries on behalf of the humanitarian community using one Mi8 helicopter based in Rumbek, one Mi8 helicopter based in Bor, and a fixed-wing aircraft based in Juba.

## 2. Inter-Cluster Working Group Priority Locations

---

- The Logistics Cluster Rumbek shared the priority locations as confirmed by the Inter-Cluster Working Group (ICWG):
  - **Kajo Keji** - accessible by road
  - **Cueibet** - accessible by road
  - **Yirol West** - accessible by road
  - **Panyikang and Canal/Pigi counties** - served by river or air
  - **Pibor County** - served by air
  - **Nassir and Maiwut counties** - served by air
  - **Boma** - served by air
  - **Uror** - served by air
  - **Ulang** - served by air
- Organisations were advised to submit Service Request Forms (SRFs) if they have goods to be transported by air or river to both priority and non-priority locations.

---

## 3. Barge and Convoy Movements

- The barge will be loaded next week with departure date to be confirmed.
- The Western Corridor convoy departed Juba on 31 May, with the next convoy tentatively planned for departure on Friday 14 June.
- Organisations were advised take note of the [Weekly Transport Plan](#) on the [Logistics Cluster website](#) for upcoming departure dates.

## 4. Common Storage and Transport Service

- The Logistics Cluster advised partners that there is currently available storage space for humanitarian organisations in the three Logistics Cluster Mobile Storage Units.
- Three Common Transport Service trucks are dedicated to shunt cargo to and from warehouses and the airport and within Rumbek town, not beyond.

## 5. Physical Access Constraints/Road Conditions

- The latest Access Constraints map was shared with partners. The map puts special focus on the Western Corridor which is used to preposition cargo in Rumbek. The latest map is available [here](#).
- Organisations were requested to share information on road conditions along the Western Corridor to ensure that the map is kept up-to-date.

## 6. AOB

- Organisations were reminded to call the UNHAS radio room/Logistics Cluster team with weather and other updates by 7:30 local time if they are due to receive a flight that day to avoid flight delays or cancellations.
- Organisations were advised to communicate more frequently regarding stock levels in transit warehouses to minimise mistakes when submitting SRFs.
- Organisations were invited to participate in the next Logistics Cluster coordination meeting and invite other members of the humanitarian community in Rumbek to join.
