1. Air Operation

- The Logistics Cluster continues to facilitate air cargo deliveries on behalf of the humanitarian community using one Mi8 helicopter based in Rumbek and one Mi8 helicopter based in Bor.
- Two fixed-wing aircrafts are based in Juba - the new asset, CASA C295, and the Buffalo-7QSTB.
- Organisations were reminded to share special commodities clearances on time and ensure proper packaging.

2. Inter-Cluster Working Group Priority Locations

- The Logistics Cluster Rumbek shared the priority locations as confirmed by the Inter-Cluster Working Group (ICWG):
 - **Mundri East** - accessible by road
 - **Rumbek North (particularly Maper)** - accessible by road
 - **Yirol West** - accessible by road
 - **Boma** - served by air
 - **Uror** - served by air
 - **Nassir and Maiwut counties** - served by air
 - **Panyikang, Canal/Pigi Triangle** - served by air/river
 - **Kajo Keji** – convoy coordinated by the Logistics Cluster
- Organisations were advised to submit [Service Request Forms](#) (SRFs) if they have goods to be transported by air or river to both priority and non-priority locations.
- Organisations were reminded that the Logistics Cluster does not define priority locations. Requests for new priority locations should be raised with the ICWG through the relevant cluster.

3. Barge and Convoy Movements

- The barge departed Bor for Malakal on 24 June; the final arrival date is yet to be confirmed.
- The Western Corridor convoy is expected to depart on 29 June.
- Organisations were advised to take note of the [Weekly Transport Plan](#) on the [Logistics Cluster website](#) for upcoming movements and deadlines.

4. Common Storage and Transport Service

- The Logistics Cluster advised partners that there is currently available storage space for humanitarian organisations in the three Logistics Cluster Mobile Storage Units.
- Three Common Transport Service trucks are dedicated to shunt cargo between the warehouses, the airport and within Rumbek town only.

5. Physical Access Constraints/Road Conditions

- The latest Access Constraints map was shared with partners. The map puts special focus on the Western Corridor which is used to preposition cargo in Rumbek. - Organisations were requested to share information on road conditions along the Western Corridor to ensure that the map is kept up-to-date.

6. AOB

- Organisations were reminded to call the UNHAS radio room and/or the Logistics Cluster team with weather and other updates by 7:30 local time if they are due to receive a flight that day to avoid flight delays or cancellations.
- Organisations were advised to communicate more frequently their stock levels in transit warehouses to minimise mistakes when submitting SRFs.
- Organisations were invited to participate in the next Logistics Cluster coordination meeting and invite other members of the humanitarian community in Rumbek to join.
