1. Logistics Cluster Operational Update

- The Carter Center requested that the Logistics Cluster support its upcoming Beyond Wau Response to Tonj North with transportation of health and operational items. The organisation will also request increased storage capacity in 2019 as part of dry season pre-positioning activities.
- COER will request that the Logistics Cluster support them in the transportation of seeds to Raja as part of their dry season pre-positioning activities.
- IMC will request Logistics Cluster support in the reception of cargo in Wau in the coming weeks. The cargo will be received at the airport and stored in the Logistics Cluster warehouse before transportation to its final destination.
- DORCAS AID will request the use of Logistics Cluster storage facilities in the coming weeks.
- UNICEF is requesting the assistance of the Logistics Cluster in transporting education and nutrition items from Wau to Kuajok. The UNICEF logistics unit is preparing a request for this movement. The date of the movement is yet to be fixed.
- Organisations have been invited to submit their requests for transportation to Bazia, Bagari and Mboro for the preparation of upcoming movements.

2. Western Corridor Convoys Coordination

- IMC is planning to send one truck from Juba to Wau through the Western Corridor.
- The next Logistics Cluster convoy will depart on 9 November. Organisations wanting to join should contact the Logistics Cluster in Juba.

3. Access Constraints

- OCHA is facing difficulties in obtaining access clearance documents for movements to Bagari, Bazia, Farajjalah and other locations.
