1. Logistics Cluster Operational Update

- Logistics Cluster is waiting on a request from UNICEF to transport nutrition items from Wau to Bor Medina. The movement is planned for mid-March.
- Malteser International will request transport for WASH items from Wau to Dem Zubeir.
- ACTED will resume food distribution in the Protection of Civilians (POC) camp next week. Due to the reduced number of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs), there may be food remaining. ACTED advised that the Logistics Cluster may need to provide transport to return the excess to WFP.
- South Sudan Red Cross will have a 20-foot container with 3 mt of cargo arriving next week. The Logistics Cluster has been requested to provide craning services to assist with the offloading of the container.

2. Convoy and Storage

- Concerns were raised with the number of checkpoints charging fees on the Juba-Terekake-Rumbek-Wau route.
- The Carter Center will conduct a joint physical inventory of the warehouse with the Logistics Cluster. Partners will be advised of the results and all stock close to expiry dates should be removed from the warehouse to create space for new cargo.

3. AOB

- Organisations wanting to move cargo to these locations should submit transport requests to the Logistics Cluster.
