## 1. Operational Update

---

- Dorcas Aid International have expressed interest in joining the upcoming Logistics Cluster Western Corridor convoy. Guidance will be requested from the Logistics Cluster once the cars they wish to transport are delivered to Juba.
- IOM advised the Logistics Cluster and its partners that the use of the Common Transport Service (CTS) trucks will not change under the new management of the Head of Sub-office. It was confirmed that the SOPs and all the procedures will remain the same and that all the locations will be reached as long as there is physical access.
- The Logistics Cluster requested that partners provide information about any convoys from Juba to Wau they are organising independently of the cluster, so that the Logistics Cluster can inform partners of potential options to move cargo back to Juba.
- Partners were informed that the road from Wau to Tonj North is still accessible to all vehicle types however partners are still advised to get clearance and road updates prior to departure. The Tonj North to Tonj East road is completely impassable due to heavy rain. The Logistics Cluster will continue to monitor this and will inform partners accordingly.

## 2. Beyond Wau Response (BWR)

---

- Partners were informed that the BWR is still in progress even though there has been some deterioration of road conditions, especially the roads from Deim Zubeir to Raja and Dolo, and from Raja to Bor Medina. Please note that all other locations in Wau, Warrap and Aweil States are still accessible. Partners were advised to continue submitting Service Request Forms (SRFs) for all of these locations.
