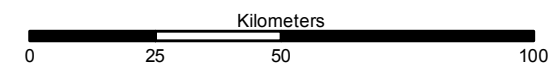


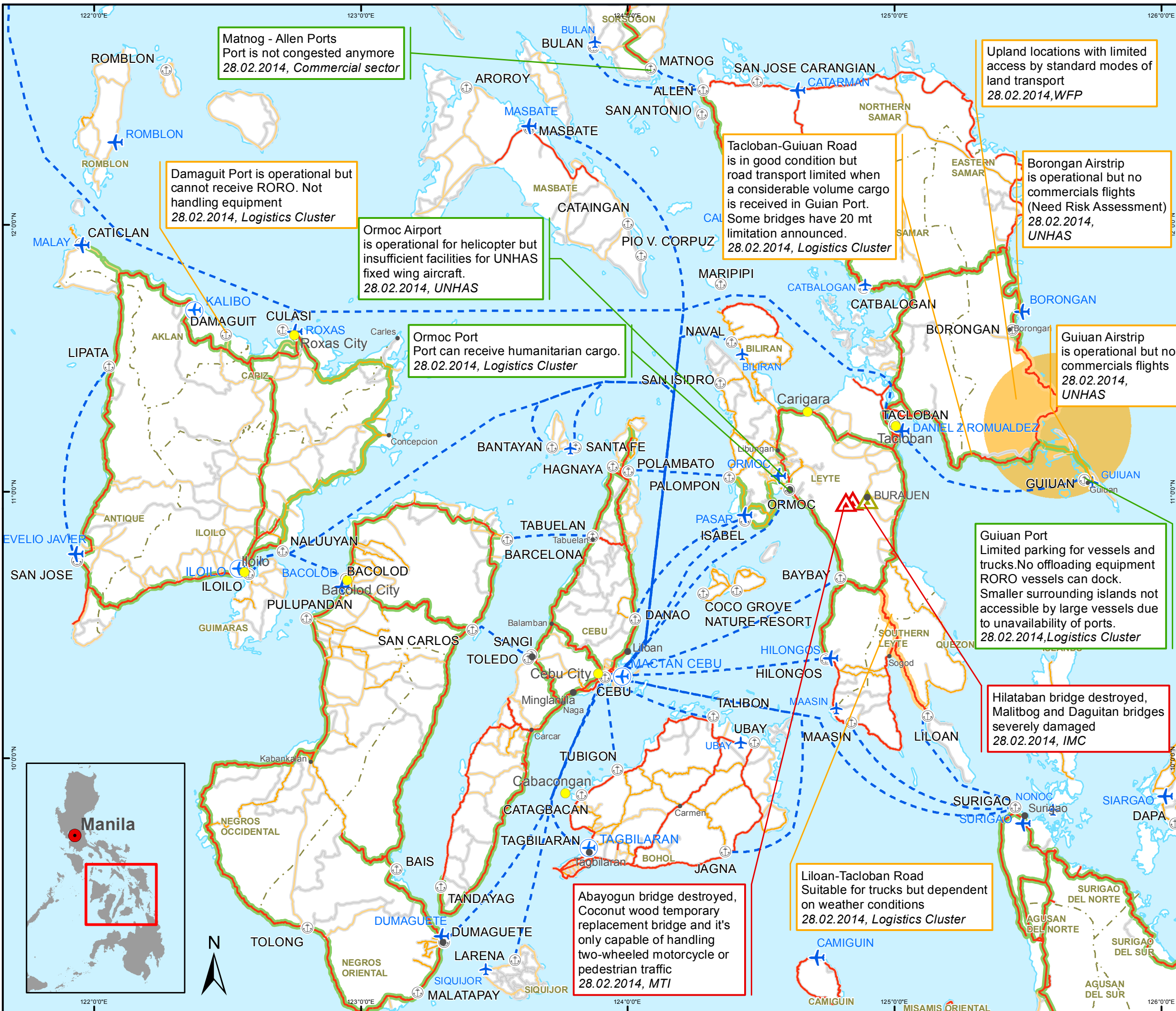

Matnog - Allen Ports  
Port is not congested anymore  
28.02.2014, Commercial sector

Damaguit Port is operational but cannot receive RORO. Not handling equipment  
28.02.2014, Logistics Cluster

Ormoc Airport is operational for helicopter but insufficient facilities for UNHAS fixed wing aircraft.  
28.02.2014, UNHAS

Ormoc Port Port can receive humanitarian cargo.  
28.02.2014, Logistics Cluster

Tacloban-Guiuan Road is in good condition but road transport limited when a considerable volume cargo is received in Guiuan Port. Some bridges have 20 mt limitation announced.

Upland locations with limited access by standard modes of land transport  
28.02.2014, WFP

Borongan Airstrip is operational but no commercial flights (Need Risk Assessment)  
28.02.2014, UNHAS

Guiuan Airstrip is operational but no commercial flights  
28.02.2014, UNHAS

Guiuan Port Limited parking for vessels and trucks. No offloading equipment RORO vessels can dock. Smaller surrounding islands not accessible by large vessels due to unavailability of ports.

Hilataban bridge destroyed, Malitbog and Daguitan bridges severely damaged  
28.02.2014, IMC

Abayogun bridge destroyed, Coconut wood temporary replacement bridge and it's only capable of handling two-wheeled motorcycle or pedestrian traffic  
28.02.2014, MTI

Liloan-Tacloban Road Suitable for trucks but dependent on weather conditions
