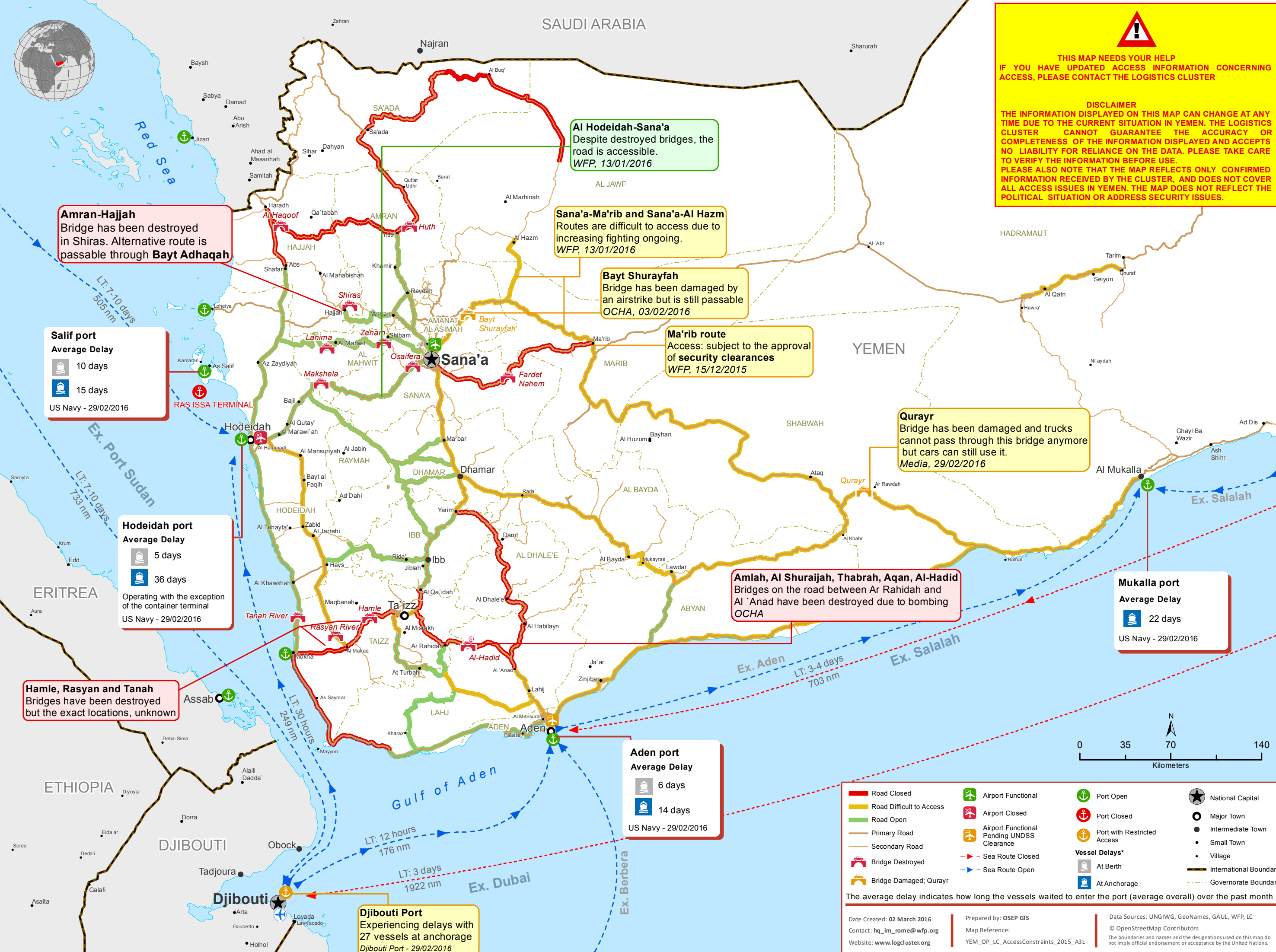

Routes are difficult to access due to increasing fighting ongoing.
