- A quick recap and reminder of the <u>CHOCOLAT</u> Platform was presented to participants about sharing cargo and transport needs and capacity
- A brief overview of the SADIC Bulletin Number 7 was presented to the members

- o Limit the spread of COVID-19 through transport across borders
- o Facilitate implementation of transport related national COVID-19 measures
- o Facilitate interstate flow of goods and services
- o Institute safe measures to allow movement of passengers across borders
- o Balance, align, harmonize and coordinate COVID-19 response measures
- WFP has developed a mobile app version of the humanitarian booking hub that can be found on apple store, Google Play as well as the humanitarian hub website. Members were encouraged to download for ease of use

2. WFP Aviation Updates

- Partners were informed about the flight schedule of the Malawi flights every Tuesdays and Thursdays
 - The <u>humanitarian booking hub</u> contains updated flight schedules and all related flight information
 - Health and Immigration procedural requirements were circulated via email and WhatsApp including:
 - testing upon arrival in Malawi
 - self-quarantine or institutional quarantine depending on results
 - regular immigration rules still apply
 - The Addis Ababa transit arrangements procedures to be followed for all travelling through the Addis Ababa hub
 - Follow the link for a comprehensive view

3. Free to user services

A reminder to partners that the National Logistics Cluster is now providing its services on a free to user basis under the COVID-19 response.

- Partners were reminded of the user common services (Mobile Storage Units, Storage and road transport) with reference to the Conops and SOPs documents in google drive
- Service Request Forms must be submitted at least 72hours in advance
 - This will allow for better operational planning and more efficient use of resources.
- Service Request Forms (SRF) must be sent to <u>malawi.covid19@wfp.org</u>

4. National response updates

- The Directorate of Road traffic and Safety Services (DRTSS) has issued a circular on the mandatory use of face masks to all clients effective 1 July 2020
- Members notified that the next flight with WFP Global Passenger Air Service to Malawi will be on the 7th of July
