Air Vanuatu	27 August: Air Vanuatu was granted approval by NDMO to operate a series of international freighter (cargo) services from August through to December 2020. Outbound passengers, departing from Port-Vila only, are allowed to travel on these services. Fiji Airways	25 August: Fiji Airways will operate a repatriation flight between Nadi-Nuku'alofa on Saturday 29th August and the return Nuku'alofa-Nadi on the same day. This flight is to assist citizens and residents to return home. The acceptance criteria is as follows: From Nadi: • All Tongan nationals are required to get a COVID-19 test done 3 days prior to departure and will be required to quarantine upon arrival • Other passport holders wishing to travel to Tonga will need prior approval from Tongan Immigration and Health Ministry From Nuku'alofa: • All Fiji citizens and Fiji residents returning are required to go into mandatory quarantine for 14 days in a government mandated facility. They will not be able to go to their residences • Transit passengers will also be considered for approval by Immigration provided the connecting flight is on the same day and within a 5 to 6 hour period (timing to be confirmed). Transiting passengers must have prior written permission from Fiji Immigration before acceptance onto the flight All guests may be subject to further health screenings at check-in. 12 August 2020: Fiji Airways, Fiji's national airline, has extended the cancellation of scheduled international services through to the end of September.
