Air Niugini	The Australian Government has announced changes to the requirements for travel to Australia. Air Niugini will continue to operate the five flights per week to Brisbane and the Monday flight to Cairns. However these new restrictions also include very significant reductions in the number of passengers allowed to be uplifted to Australia.
