1. Situation Updates

UNHAS Updates

- United Nations Humanitarian Air Service (UNHAS) informed partners that there was no passenger flight in the past week.

2. Logistics Cluster Operational Updates

- 3 mt of Health items belonging to one partner were dispatched from the Mekelle warehouse on 27 October 2022. The items were picked by the partner to be distributed to 15 different health facilities in Tigray. The Tigray regional health bureau supported with trucks.

- Partners were also informed that the Logistics Cluster supported one partner with three trucks of 40 mt to transport WASH and Shelter items from Mekelle to the Quiha internally displaced persons (IDPs) site on 1 November 2022.
 - The Logistics Cluster shared the current warehouse capacity for Mekelle with partners. The total size of the warehouse is 3,500 m². Currently, 1200 m² are occupied by cargo on behalf of eight partners, representing a warehouse occupation rate of 34.3%.

3. FAQs and Partner Discussion

- Discussions were held related to the preparedness and contingency plans for optimised storage capacity in the region when supply movements resume.
