# **Humanitarian Access and HNS Presentation for Logistics Cluster East**

20 March 2024

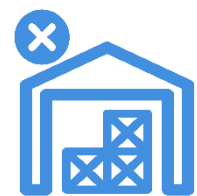
## Access Impediments in the East (Kharkivska, Donetska, Luhanska, and Zaporizka oblasts)



- 15 cases in Donetska and Kharkivska oblasts



- 2 cases of violence against humanitarian staff with 5 injured



- 9 incidents with damage to humanitarian assets and facilities



- Restriction of movements, including spike in hostilities: 4 cases

In Pokrovsk raion, security conditions deteriorate and pose additional challenges for partners to operate. Contingency planning has been initiated by clusters and OCHA.

# Changes to the Humanitarian Notification System's SOPs as of February 2024

- Notification of humanitarian movements within 20km from the frontline/international border (previously 50km)
- Optional notification of the sides to the conflict (either one of them or both; UN agencies or inter agency convoys continue to notify both)
- Suspension of the static sites's notification pending the development of new procedures with parties
- Increase in the number of NGOs using HNS observed since the beginning of the year.

- The FPs will receive training on how to use the online platform to submit notifications.

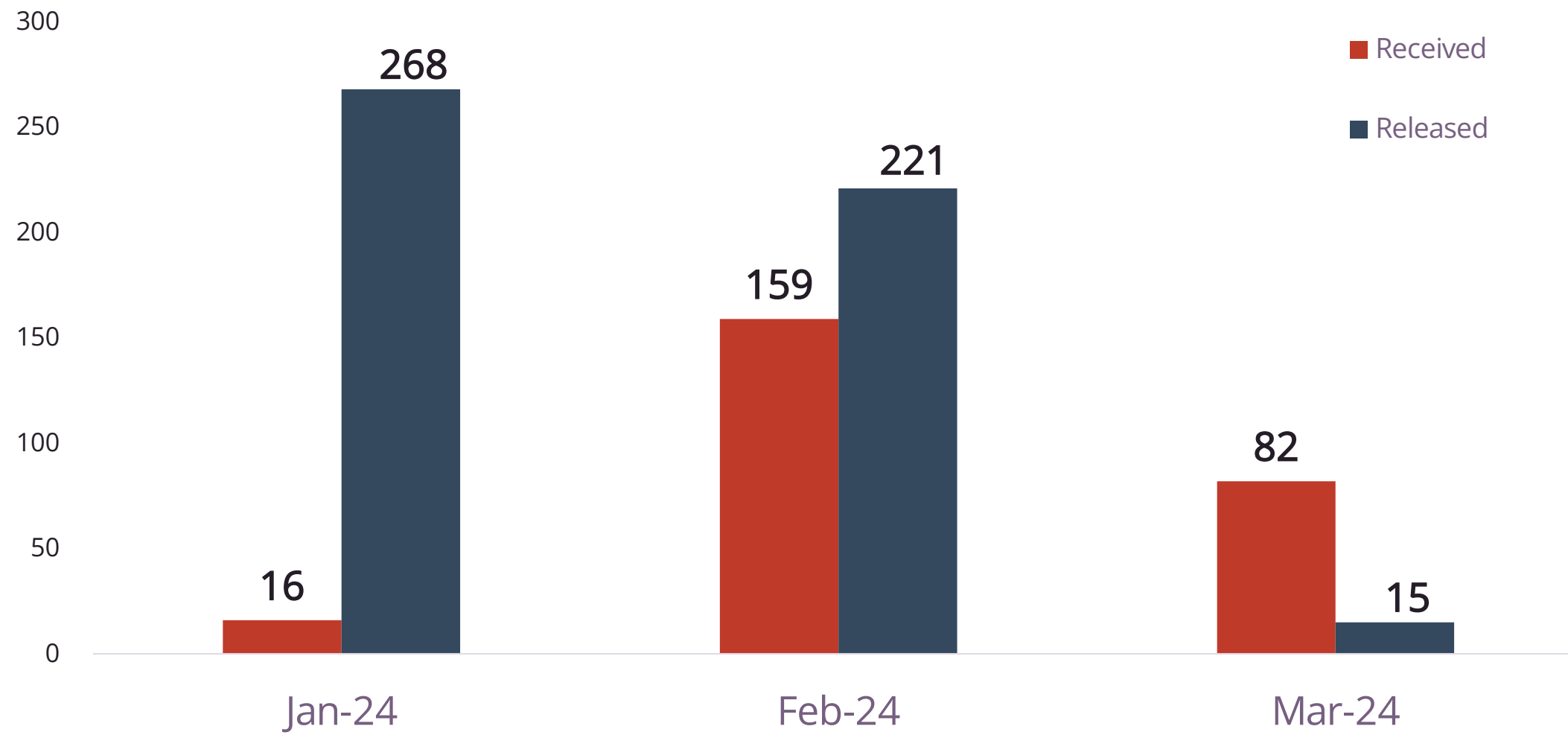

CARGO RECEIVED AND RELEASED IN DNIPRO BY MONTH IN 2024 (m3)



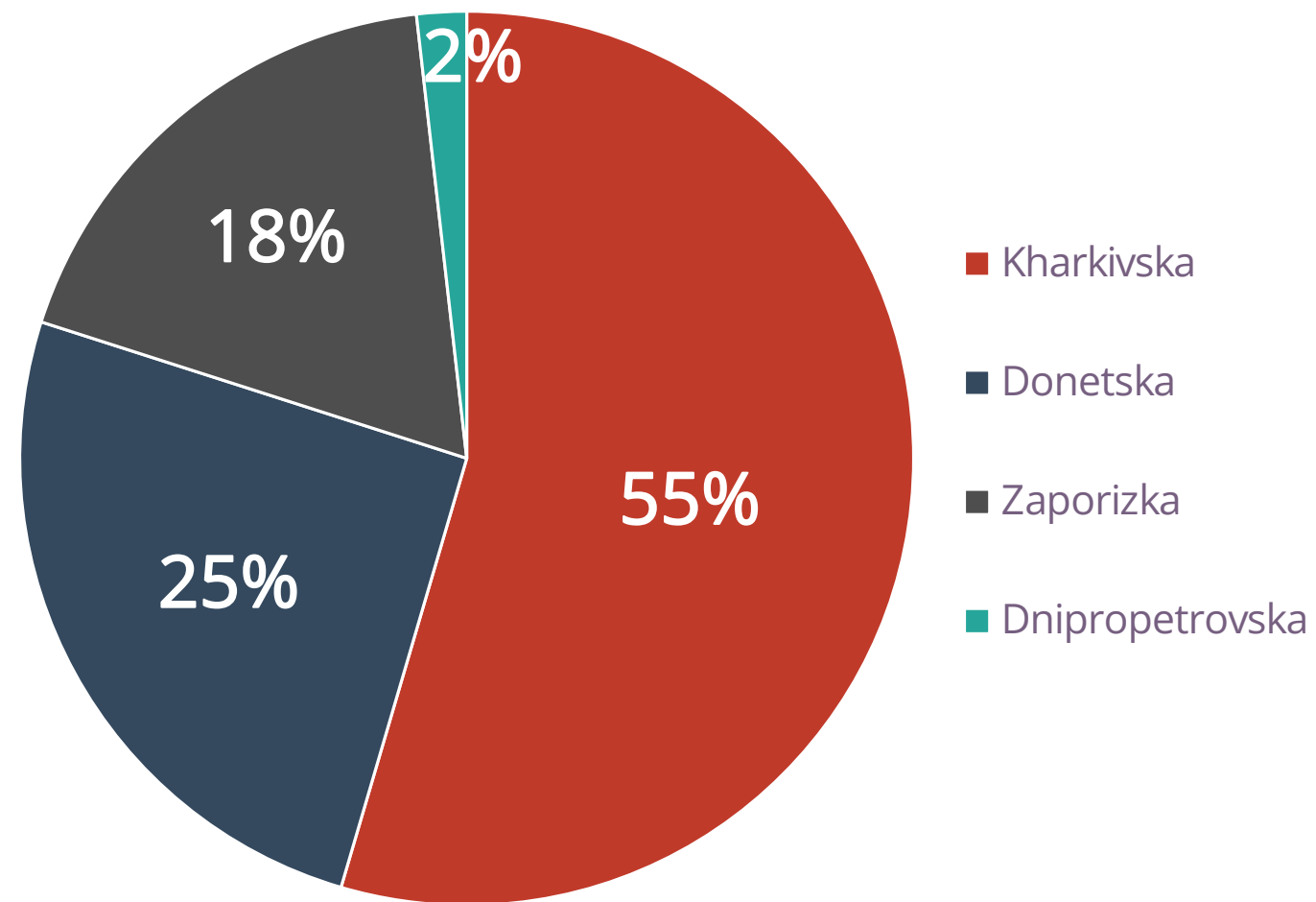

# Launch of the Automated Humanitarian Aid Registration System (AHARS)

## 01

While the implementation of the procedure was officially postponed and the two processes (online and paper) were supposed to run in parallel until 1 April, the paper declaration still requires the organisation code which should be generated through the online platform.

Furthermore, by 1 April organisations will have to upload all paper declarations for cargo imported since 1 December.

## 02

The newly adopted Resolution #953 related to import of humanitarian assistance does not allow for supplies supporting statutory activities (like vehicles, IT equipment) be declared as “humanitarian goods”.

## 03

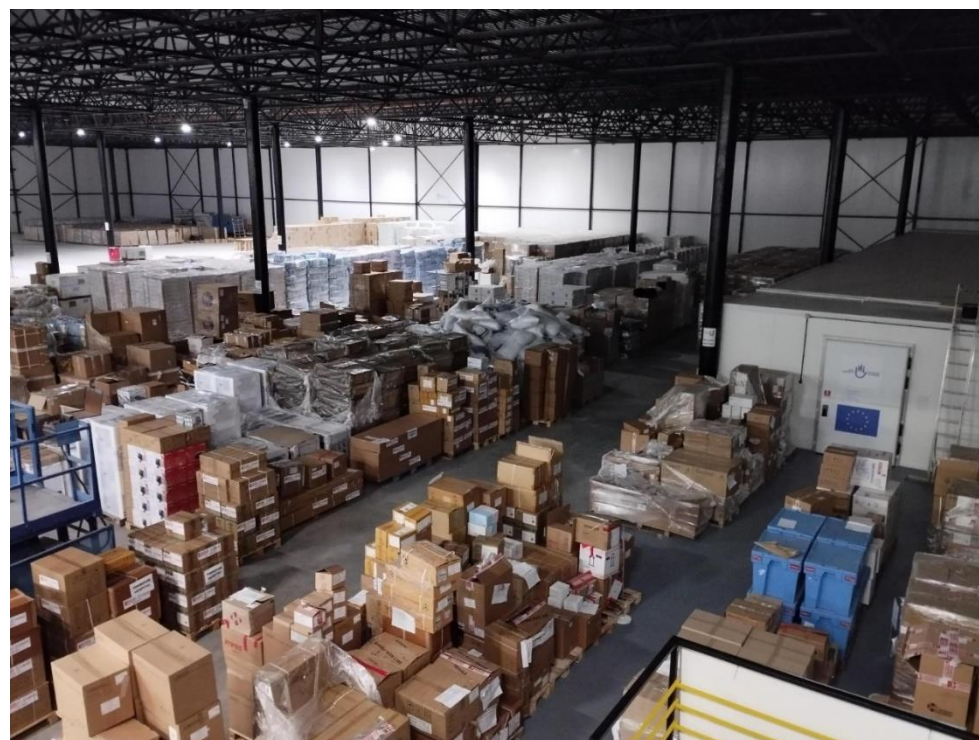
The Ministry of Social Policy (MoSP) launched Telegram channel and hotline on technical issues related to the platform and a sub-group for international organisations in English.

**NB:** Registry within the AHARS will serve as a verifiable source to identify the humanitarian organization, for not only import and reporting. For example, visa issues for humanitarian staff will be also linked to that registry.

# ATLAS LOGISTIQUE/HI UPDATE

## Storage updates

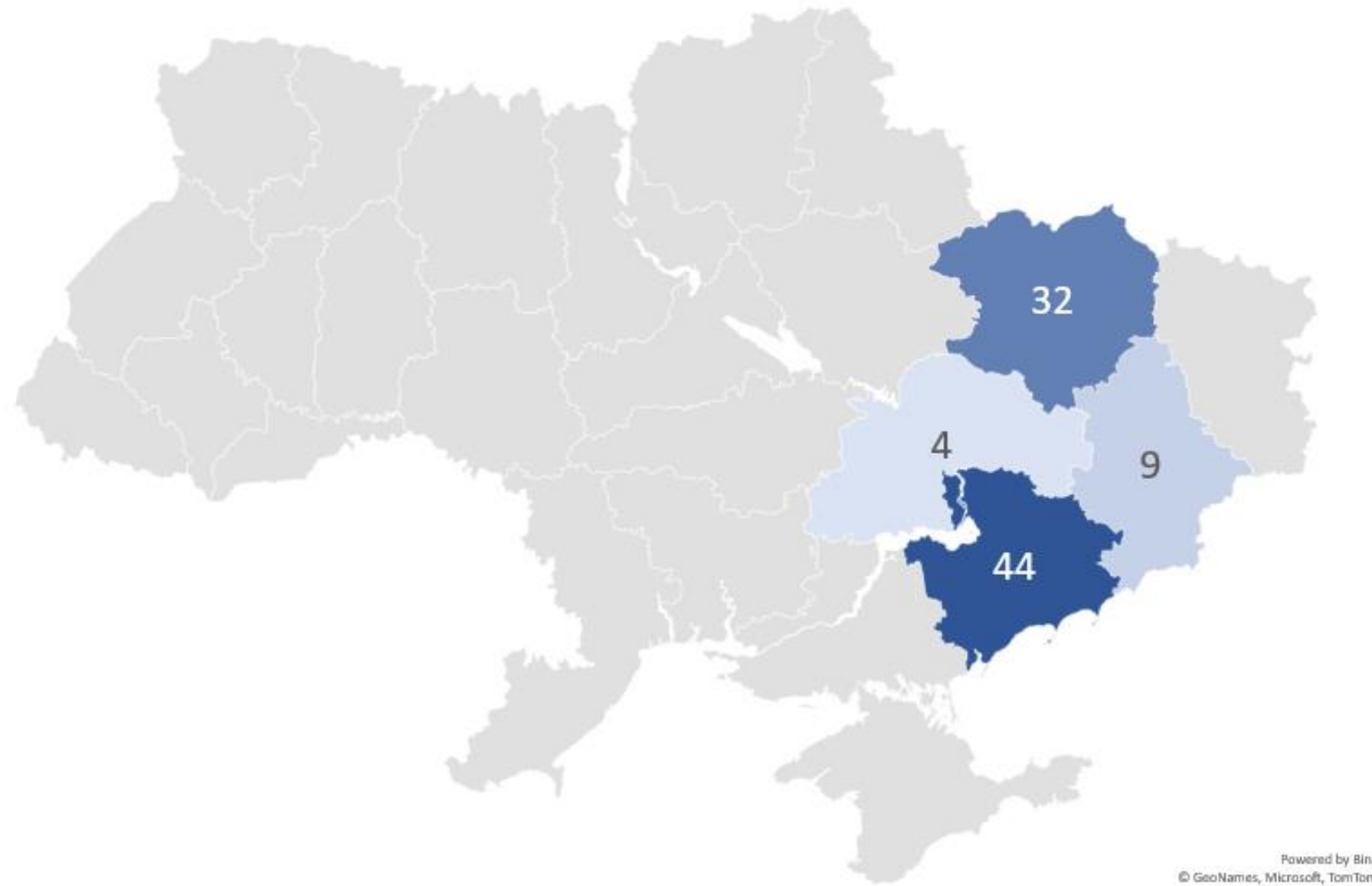


- **Dnipro and Kharkiv hubs:**
  - Dry storage available - Dnipro warehouse of 4 000 sqm and Kharkiv 2 250 sqm
  - 1 172 m<sup>3</sup> entered and 1 123 m<sup>3</sup> released on two hubs in February
  - Stable rotation of stock, space remain available (average occupation rate of 62 %)
  - Reminder: availability of kitting services in Dnipro and Kharkiv
- **Temperature controlled storage:**
  - Average occupation rate 53 % (in February 24)
  - Available in Dnipro for different temperature ranges (+15/+25°C and +2/+8°C)
  - Except in Kharkiv (only +15/+25°C for now – partners in need for +2/+8°C encouraged to let Atlas Logistique know)

## Transport updates



High level of activities in **February 2024** : **89 deliveries organized** in Eastern oblasts (68% of total deliveries) - more strict application of transport request prioritization system:

- **37%** of transports related to **winterization**
- **46%** on behalf of **local NGOs**
- **71%** to **hard-to-reach areas**, with a particular focus Kharkiv and Zaporizhzhia oblasts
- **10%** of **temperature-controlled** deliveries **+15-+25**.

## Other Atlas Logistique updates



- **Partner satisfaction survey** data collection phase completed
- Atlas Logistique updated its **SOPs** and deployed a new (simplified) **SRF template**: short training sessions were organized in Dnipro and Kharkiv
- Turnover at Atlas Logistique Program Coordinator level
- Launching of a **new capacity-building program** – participation to first training sessions in March in collaboration with IOM and the Logistics Cluster
