## 1. Overall Updates

- **Ceasefire announcement:**
  - Israeli authorities have not yet released an official communication about deliveries plan to Gaza. Initial indications suggest that 600 to 800 trucks are expected to enter Gaza daily. Of these, 250 trucks may be allocated to UN/INGOs and the rest to other actors including the Egyptian Red Crescent (ERC), the Jordan Hashemite Charity Organization (JHCO), bilateral coordinated entities and the private sector.
  - A northern Gaza crossing may reopen, though no specific crossings have yet been named.
  - No quotas for specific humanitarian routes into Gaza have been communicated.
  - No updates have been received on NGO registration or customs clearance requirements.
- Discussions are taking place to resume the Government-to-Government (G2G) convoys under new conditions, including scanning trucks and drivers inside Jordan before the King Hussein Bridge (KHB) – Allenby.
- Due to the Jewish holidays, all crossings into Gaza will be closed between 13 and 14 October, and on 16 October. West Bank crossings might be closed throughout the week with case-by-case exceptions negotiated.
- The Logistics Cluster will put the recently launched **Gaza Humanitarian Storage Capacity Survey** on hold in light of the potential ceasefire.
- The Logistics Cluster is holding weekly [Service Request Form](#) (SRF) induction sessions. These are held in English and Arabic alternately on Wednesdays. Upcoming sessions will take place on 15 October in English and on 22 October in Arabic.

## 2. Jordan Corridor

- The G2G convoys are still on hold since the 18 September incident at KHB.
- The Back-to-Back (B2B) convoys are ongoing; however, they are disrupted by border closures due to the Jewish holidays.
- Between 1 and 8 October, the Logistics Cluster facilitated access to one B2B convoy; seven shelter trucks offloaded at KS/KAS.

## 3. Egypt Corridor

- This past week, the crossing was open on 5, 9 and 10 October with Nitzana used for scanning.
- In addition to the requirement for pre-clearance through the UN2720 Mechanism and Israeli customs clearance for aid entering Gaza from Egypt, partners are still required to follow the ERC [Standard Operating Procedures](#) and notify ERC of cargo movement through the [15-day](#) or [48-hour](#) forms.
- The coordination of the Egypt corridor is led by the ERC.

## 4. Atlas Logistique in Gaza

- Atlas Logistique is an operational unit of the NGO Humanity & Inclusion (HI) specialised in the delivery of humanitarian aid.



- Atlas Logistique provides storage and transport services at no-cost to the humanitarian community. Its services function as complementary to the existing Logistics Cluster services.
  - Atlas offers storage at two warehouses totalling 1,080 sqm in Zawayda and Mussadar. Organisations can store life-saving items for up to 6 weeks.
  - Atlas offers last-mile delivery to one or several locations (e.g. distribution sites, storage spaces).

## 5. Inter-Agency Pipeline

- 28 organisations updated their active sheets. As of 6 October, the total pipeline is 804,885 m3 (equivalent to approximately 447,159 pallets), with 36 percent of the pipeline reported through Egypt, 28 percent through Ashdod, 24 percent through Jordan, two percent through Israel, one percent through the West Bank, and the remaining nine percent not yet allocated to a route.

## 6. AOB
