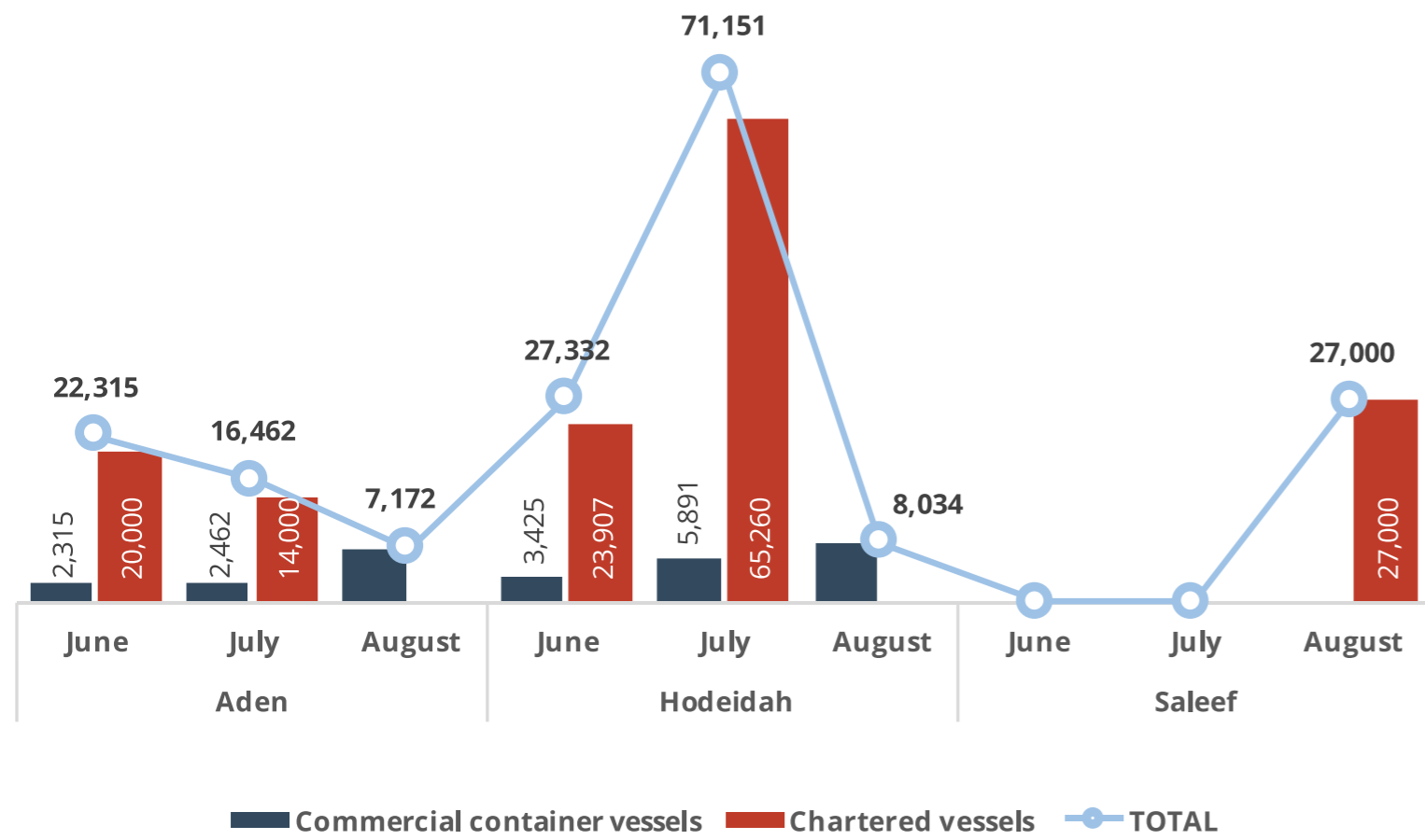

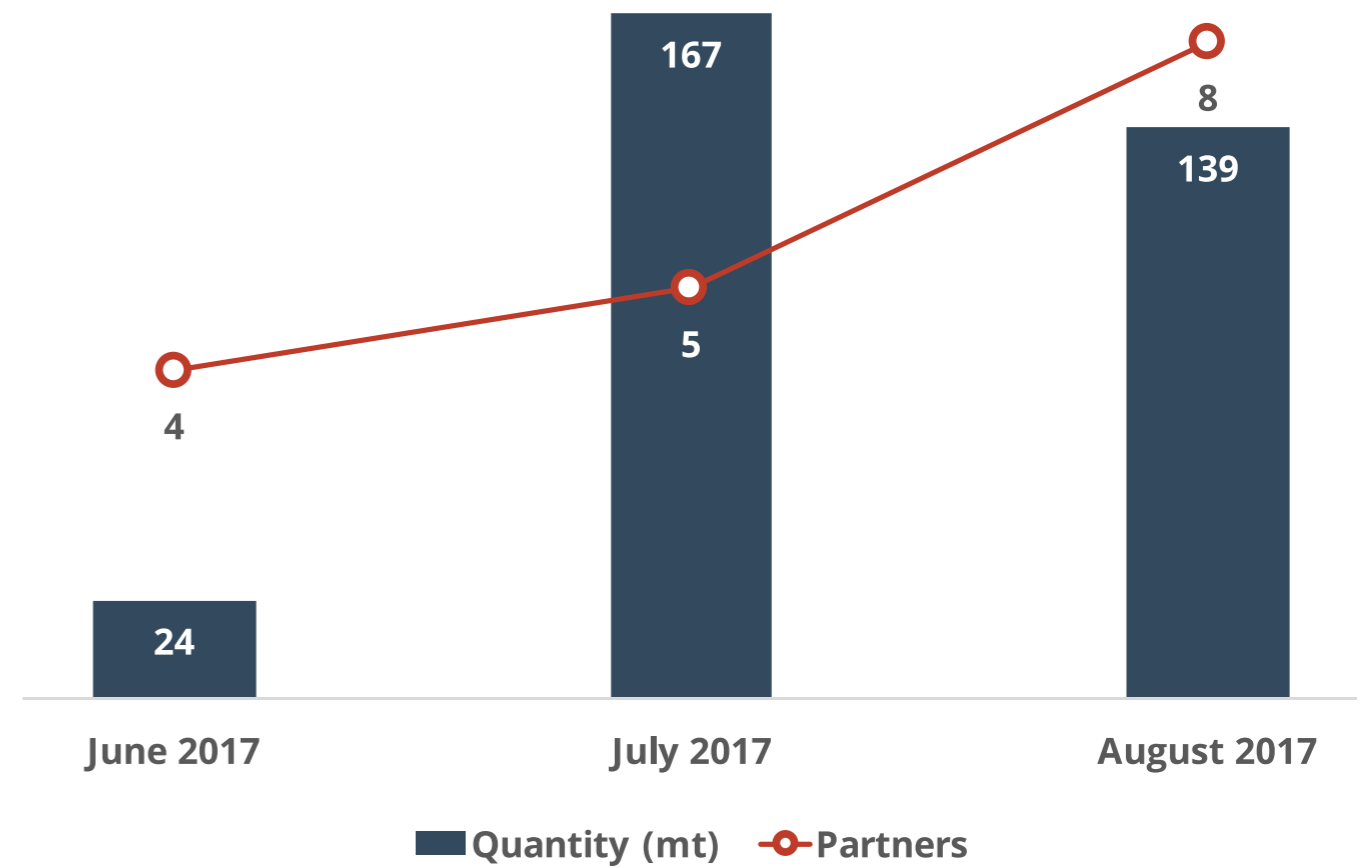

## Air deliveries facilitated by the Logistics Cluster

The Logistics Cluster facilitates combined chartered airlifts from Djibouti to Sana'a, on a frequency contingent on needs and funding. In August, an airbridge to respond to the cholera outbreak was established, carrying out a maximum of four rotations per week for a total of 12 rotations. Starting from September, the Logistics Cluster will resume chartered airlifts every two weeks to keep addressing the increased transport demands due to the cholera outbreak.

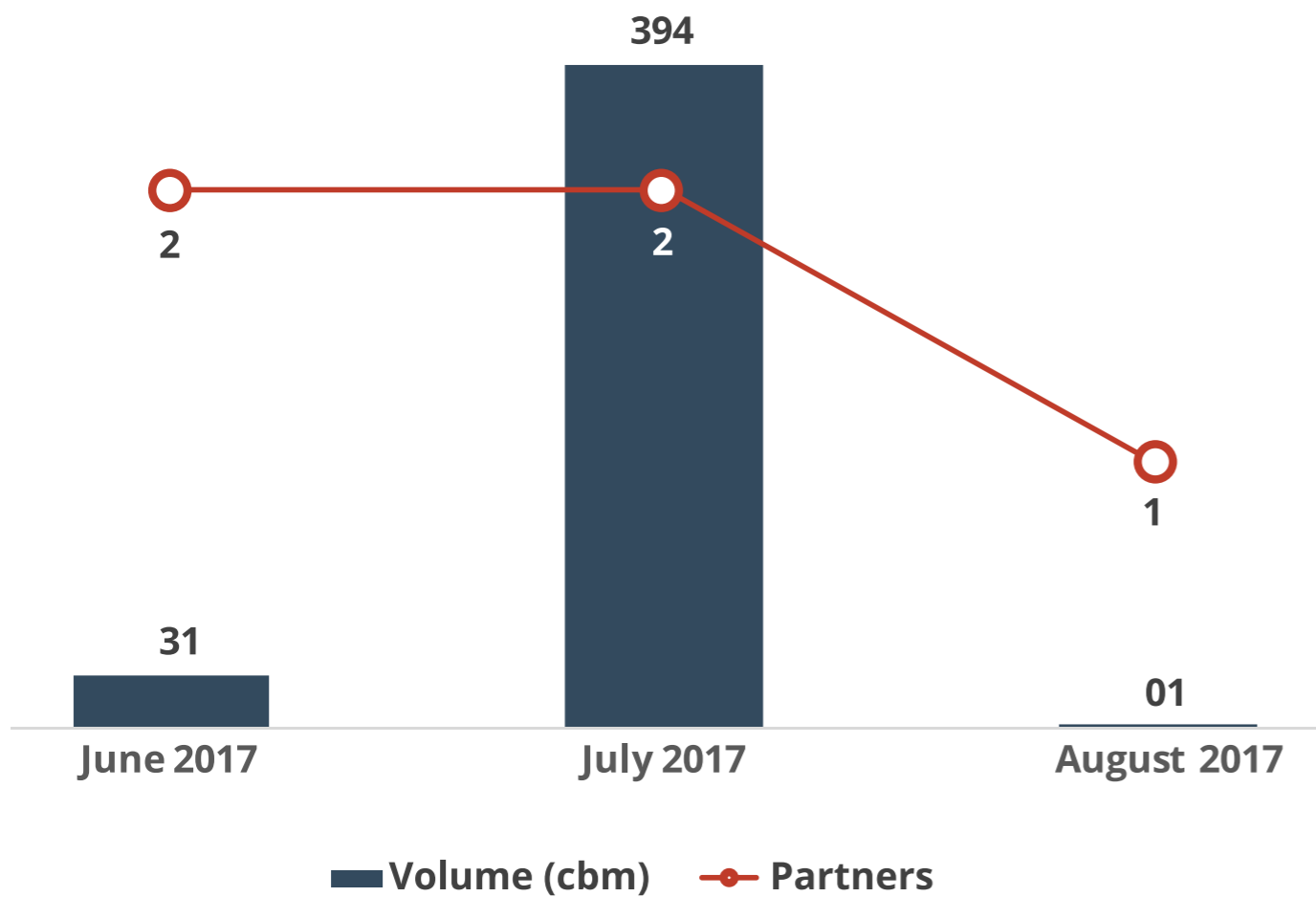

## Sea cargo transport facilitated by the Logistics Cluster

The Logistics Cluster facilitates the cargo transport via sea on board the WFP-chartered vessel VOS Apollo. This vessel operates on a weekly rotation from Djibouti to Aden. In August, 131 kg / 0.6 m3 of medical supplies were transported on behalf of UNICEF.

## Other services provided by the Logistics Cluster

Passengers transported between Djibouti and Aden on VOS Apollo  
**112 passengers from 19 organisations over four voyages**

Overland transport facilitated in Yemen (mt)  
**84 mt on behalf of 4 partners**

Liters of fuel (diesel & petrol) disbursed to partners  
**119,400 litres to 19 organisations**

Cargo received into storage in Yemen (mt)  
**144 mt on behalf of 3 partners**
